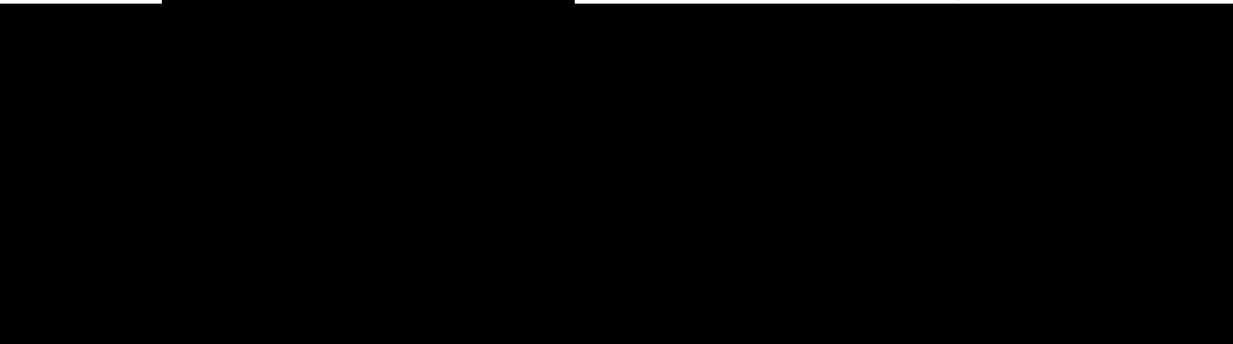

1. In late January at a meeting of the Hong Kong Executive Committee of the South China Sub-Bureau, CHIANG Tieh-sheng*, Chairman of the Committee, made the following announcements.
 - a. Chinese Communist military authorities are planning to invade Hong Kong, Macao, and Indochina soon.
 - b. All possible political and military information on these areas must be consolidated by the Committee as soon as possible.
 - c. The Committee must establish armed underground forces in Hong Kong and Macao to aid the regular Chinese Communist Army troops when the invasion is started.**
 - d. Members of the Committee should obtain positions with communications organizations in Hong Kong to aid in obtaining control of these.
2. Communists who live in Singapore, the United States, and the Philippines, or who have relatives there are being trained at Nanfang University in Canton and sent to those countries.*** From 1 December 1950 until the end of January 1951 about 300 graduates were sent to these countries.
- 25X1X 3. Communist students who have returned to China from the United States are urged to maintain contact with [REDACTED] and try to obtain information about United States defenses, factories and other items of interest.
