- On 8 January 1951 Territorial Commandant of West Java, Col. Sadikin ordered the Indonesian Military Police in Bandung to arrest the following Dutch officers on the Bandung force:
 - Police Commissioner P.A. Kettenis
 - Police Inspector A.G. Story
 - Police Inspector R.K. Wankay (an Ambonese)
 - Sub-Inspector F.H. Diekel
 - Sub-Inspector F.R. Parera
 - Chief Constable J.S. Seiten (Eurasian)
 - Chief Constable de Boer (Eurasian)
- All of the above police officers were charged with conspiracy against the Government for aiding and collaborating with the guerrilla forces known as the White Eagle, which is under the leadership of de Boer. This group operates in the Sukabumi-Tjandjur area. There are now no Dutch officers on the Bandung police force. Two days before the above arrests, Chief Police Commissioner Landmeter was arrested as he boarded the SS CRANJE in Tondjungsriok to return to Holland.
- The Police Administration Section of the Department of Interior in Djakarta has ordered the following policemen transferred from Cheribon:
 - 2nd Class Police Commissioner Hadji Sulaeman Djausman to Djakarta
 - Police Inspector Mohammed Wajudi from PAN office to rural district of Kuningan.
 - Police Inspector Raden Mohtar of the City Police's Criminal Investigation Branch to Madjalengka.

4. These men are being transferred because of their alleged connection with the extortion of money from well-to-do Chinese in Cheribon. Some Chinese in Cheribon have been arrested on suspicion or trumped up charges and in order to be released from jail immediately, were forced to give the police money. News of this practice has gotten out and the Ministry of Interior was forced to take some action.
