Juan R. Solis B., who was elected president of the new Directive Council of the Federacion de Trabajadores Bananera (FETRABA) on 1 January 1951, stated that FETRABA had requested to be incorporated into the International Confederation of Free Trade Unions (ICFTU). On instructions from Serafino Romualdi, according to source, the banana workers have broken with the Confederacion Costaricense de Trabajadores (CCT-Rerum Movarum). The motion, supported by all delegations at the meeting, was made by the Quepos syndicate at the extraordinary General Assembly of FETRARA, which convened in Colfito on 17 December 1950. The Rerum Novarum was criticised for maladministration and for retaining Father Benjamino Nunez on the National Directory Counsel in spite of his lack of responsibility in the management of affiliated syndicates. According to Solis, the separation from the Rerum Novarum was to be conducted se as to attract as little attention as possible, with only a short announcement in the newspapers.

Although FETRABA wishes to be considered an anti-Communist organization, there is record of Carmen Bojorge Guzman's having been a member of the Communist Party around 1948. Source believes that this may mean that FETRABA has been penetrated in its directorate by at least one Communist.
