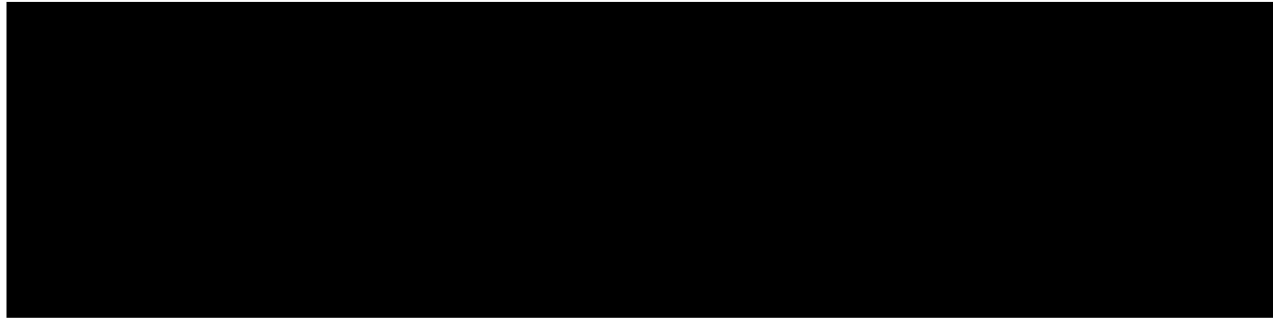

- 25X1A
1. An Engineer Battalion which belongs to the Engineer Regiment at Shumen arrived in the district of Michurin (Turkish border) in the first part of [REDACTED]. Its mission was to prepare frontier roads and bridges for mining. The soldiers bored holes into the cement walls on the sides of bridges into which mines will be fitted in case of emergency.
  2. The following roads were prepared for mining:
    - a. Michurin-Varvara-Ahtapol-Sinomorets-Rezovo;
    - b. Michurin-Izgreve-Marzovo-Gramatikovo-Malko Tirnovo.
