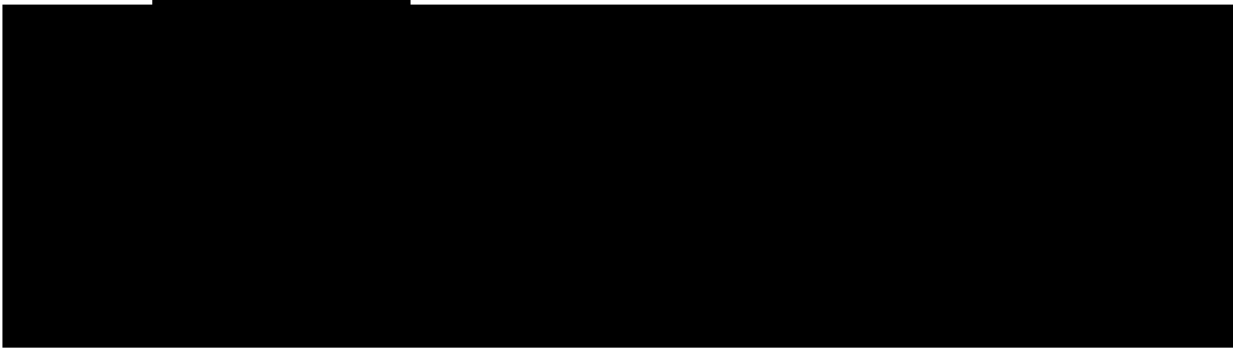

1. General NE WIN and his associate Bo SET KYA (aka AUNG THAN) make large contributions to the Burma Communist Party (BCP).\*
2. In addition, NE WIN warns the BCP of major operations planned by the Burma War Office against it.
3. He warned the BCP, for instance, of the Burma Government's intention to launch a major offensive against the People's Democratic Front on the Irrawaddy axis in May 1950.\*\*

25X1A \* [REDACTED] Comment. Other prominent individuals in Rangoon also make large contributions to the BCP. However, the bulk of BCP funds come from compulsory levies in villages in areas occupied by the Party.

25X1A \*\* [REDACTED] Comment. NE WIN and his friends are evidently determined to keep a foot in both camps.
