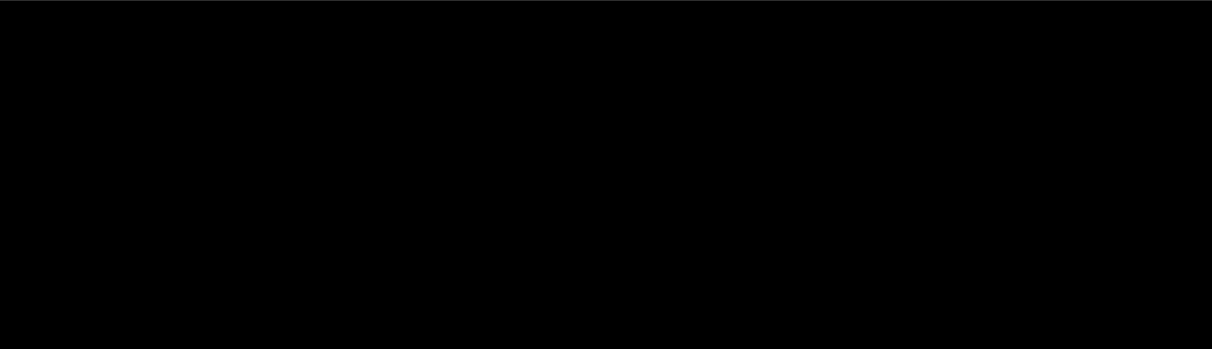

SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO.



1. The Executive Committee of the Communist Party of Chile (PCCh) is reported to have received from unknown sources a message purportedly written by the Union of Democratic Women of Korea. Instructions were issued by the PCCh to the Comite Feminino de Unidad to publish and distribute this message throughout Chile. Lucy Loreh (aka Olga Gutierrez), Communist sculptress and artist who was assigned the task of publishing this information, prepared the cover design for the propaganda, which was mimeographed in the form of a four-page pamphlet. Five thousand copies were prepared for sale at two pesos each.
2. The sale of this propaganda pamphlet, under the title Corea te Llamo (Korea Calls You), has reportedly been very successful, and it has been necessary to publish two thousand additional copies to satisfy the demand.
3. The pamphlet describes the sad fate of Korea at the hand of the American aggressors and of Syngman Rhee. Alleged American atrocities are luridly pictured. It is dated 5 January 1951, and signed by the Union of Democratic Women of Korea, and was prepared by Pak Den Ali, Yu En Dyun, Li Kym Sun, Cho Bok Me.\*
4. It is reported that the pamphlet has been read at several cell meetings of Party members in Santiago, and it had such an effect on its hearers that many went while listening to it. According to source, it has been responsible for renewed pro-peace activity by many Party members.

25X1A [REDACTED] It is believed that this organization may be identical with the North Korea Democratic Women's League, the three leaders of which are PAK Chong-ae, YI Kum-sun, and KIM Kyu-son.
