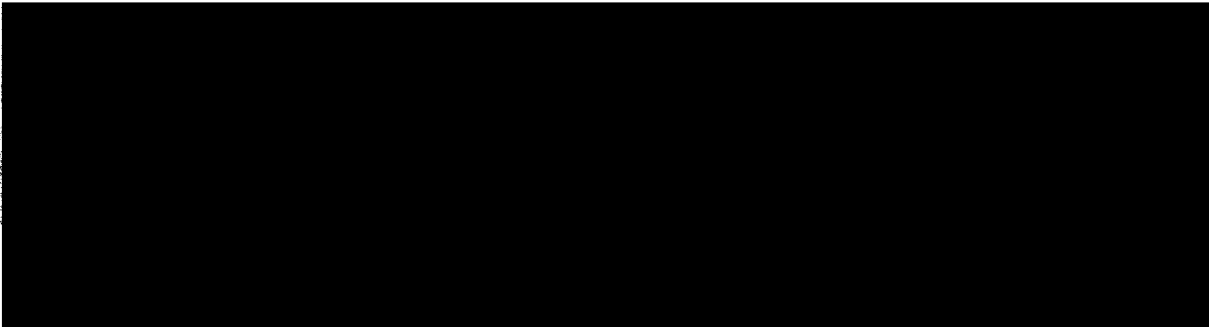
SUBJECT UDB Arrest of Bulgarians with Yugoslav Citizenship

1. In mid-November 1950 the UDB in Caribrod arrested a large number of Bulgarians of Yugoslav citizenship who were allegedly plotting a revolt and the assassination of numerous prominent Yugoslav Government officials.
2. The organizers of the revolt are alleged to have been Bulgarians employed as Yugoslav Party and Government functionaries who enjoyed a fair amount of authority under the regime. Among the leaders were the President of the District People's Committee, the President of the City People's Committee, and a professor in the teachers' school, all of Caribrod.
3. The UDB discovered the existence and plans of the organization through students in Caribrod who were approached by the unidentified professor in the course of his efforts to organize the youth. The professor was arrested by the UDB and subsequently revealed the identity of his collaborators.
