"The Permanent Commission of the Urban Committee to members of the party working in the midst of the enemy.

1. "For some time, because a break in liaison, our foundation was partially damaged and the Permanent Commission could not be in direct contact with its members to guide their activities. A large part of its members were therefore obliged to cease their activities. Because of this, the urban direction of the party was also obliged to slow down its action...
2. "Comrades, the Vietnamese people can follow only one road: to expel the imperialist invaders and bring independence and liberty to the country. We wish peace; we must begin by combatting and annihilating the colonialists provokers at any price.
3. "How will the general offensive be conducted? It is important, comrades, that you know exactly what the partisan's responsibility will be during this new period of (Viet Nam's) history.
4. "The general offensive is first of all an awakening of the people after years of preparation. Our offensive will in no way depend on foreign troops as the principal liberation force. On the contrary, the principal force will be the Vietnamese people, the large majority of whom will become armed forces on the battlefield. The liberation of the nation is the duty of the people, who must today fully participate in the resistance movement to annihilate the enemy. No one must hesitate, because to hesitate is to endanger the country and the people. There will be moments of intensive fighting on all fronts and others of abatement. This is because of reasons known to the resistance (leaders). They will be made known to you in time.

5. Our general offensive may be long and hard because of the possibility of the abandonment of Tonkin by the enemy in order to consolidate the southern front....
6. Nha Trang is a strategic area for the enemy in South Viet Nam and a plentiful arms store. Nha Trang is also a key point for direct liaison with Cam Ranh, the most important spot in the region.
7. To aid the general offensive to hasten victory and minimize the amount of bloodshed, we must organize and mobilize all the people, so that they will know how to avoid the enemy, to harass him and to keep ahead of him. Functionaries in the service of the French must be able to be efficient soldiers in time of open combat, ready to fight the enemy in his own camp. We must destroy all his stores in order to paralyze his food program and bring about his downfall.
8. In order to perform the above task, we must transform Nha Trang into a strong section of the party and supply the people with propaganda so that they will understand their responsibilities now and at the moment of the general offensive. We must enroll the people into Resistance Committees. This is the moment to immediately consolidate the people's organizations....
