Colonel Jean Leroy, commander of the Unites Mobiles de Defense des Chretientes (U.DC), states that he now has under his command 4,500 regular forces, plus 13-14,000 supplementary troops, including the auto-defense units of 97 vil-1.0 lages.* The regular forces are equipped with one machine gun for every 10 men; the supplementary troops have one machine gun for 30 men and one submachine gun for every 10 men. Leroy's forces have about 40 radios, with trained personnel to operate them.

- In the event Indochina is taken over by the Communists, Leroy states he can count on the support of 10,000 partisans to form resistance cells and fight on.
- The island of Minh, where UFDC forces recently carried out a fairly largescale operation, is the only are in Leroy's zone of operations which he does not control. He expects all resistance on the island to be wiped out 25X1A by 25X TArch.

Colonel Lercy's views on the military Comment. situation in South Viet Nam, estimates his force at about 5,000.
