1. The East German Ambassador to Hungary reported the following to his government on 13 February 1951:
  - a. The morale of Hungarian workers is very low.
  - b. Production is 25 per cent. below the planned figures.
  - c. The responsible ministry has no contact with the factories and mines in Hungary.
  - d. There is unsatisfactory Socialist competition in discipline.
  - e. There are shortcomings in the factories throughout all Hungary.
2. The report added that 200,000 new laborers have been recruited for work in factories, and that there is a need for tens of thousands of new youth leaders to create a more active and resolute youth to support the Hungarian Workers' Party.
