

- 1. As of November 1950 there were known to be four branches of the All-China Seamen's Union; namely, the North, Northeast, East and South China branches. This Union was instituted by the All-China Federation of Labor at a meeting in December 1949 in Peiping. A vice chairman of the Union is HSIAO Lu (美).
- 2. The North China Branch of the Union publishes a magazine known as the North China Seamen, which once printed a letter from the Seamen's International Union.
- Conferences of the Union have been held in Canton in March 1950, in Dairen in April 1950, and in Shanghai in May 1950.
