1. From early December to 20 March the Chinese Communist authorities in Central Kwangtung had confiscated 82 telephones, about 7,000 pounds of lead-covered wire, two generators, and four large cases of electrical supplies from homes and shops. The registration of all radios and electrical supplies in homes and shops of Kwangtung was started in early December.

2. Since 15 February when travel permits were required for entry [redacted] through Kwangtung, business [redacted] decreased. As a result in early March travel controls were relaxed and travel permits were no longer required of merchants bringing in military supplies.
