1. On 17 March 1951 the following ships left Ich'ang (111-17, 30-42) empty to pick up troops at Wansien (108-24, 30-49) for shipment down the Yangtze: The 677-ton MIN T'AI, the 742-ton MIN FENG (民鋒), the 547-ton MIN LAI, the 437-ton MIN HSI, the 498-ton MIN SU and one other ship.
2. On 18 March, 564 troops left Wansien for Ich'ang on the MIN LAI.
3. On 18 March, 245 troops left Chungking for Ich'ang on the CHIANG YUEH (江岳).
