1. Alexander A. Yaron, a stateless refugee of Russian birth, who was arrested in the Dominican Republic in October 1950 and ordered to leave the country, is reportedly still in the Dominican Republic. According to source, he has no immediate need to leave at the present time.
2. Yaron originally desired to obtain a Mexican visa, but his application was refused. However, if he were suddenly expelled from the Dominican Republic, he would be able to go to one of the French possessions, either Martinique or Guadeloupe, as he has been issued a visa by the French Consulate.
3. Yaron, a painter, is reported to be earning between \$500 and \$600 U.S. a month.
