1. On 18 February 1951, about 1,000 laborers were improving the Wolzow (N 52/A 44) airfield. The field was being enlarged toward Bahndorf (N 52/A 44). For this purpose three farms belonging to Bahndorf were confiscated. A construction laborer said that an additional 500 laborers were to be employed soon. Two concrete runways, or a taxiway and a runway, were said to be planned for the field. [REDACTED]
