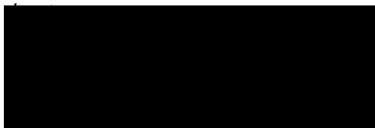

While the two important posts of Minister of Defense and Minister of Interior remain vacant, Ali Budiardjo, Secretary General of the Ministry of Defense, and Wongsonegoro, Secretary General of the Ministry of Interior, have been supervising and handling routine affairs in their respective ministries. Neither one has the authority to initiate or determine Government policy with regard to internal security. Since Asaat's resignation as Minister of Interior, this department has been undergoing a reorganization. The Indonesian Civil Police under Sukanto may be removed from the Ministry's control and set up as an autonomous department with a permanent staff. However, it will maintain liaison with both the Ministries of Interior and Justice. Although Police Chief Sukanto would report directly to the Prime Minister, his position could not be affected by any change of cabinet.
2. Many observers of the Indonesian political scene feel that Sjahrir should form a new cabinet, cutting across party lines. The following cabinet is recommended:
