Apart from the fact that AAA troops from the Artillerie Kaserne had left the post, the military situation at the Frankfurt/Oder military post was unchanged until 1 March 1951. On 25 February, about 300 troops wearing red-bordered black epaulets, eleven 76.2-mm AA guns, and eight trucks with numbers of the [REDACTED] series were seen moving to the military ramp for loading on trains. On 26 February, about 200 troops wearing red-bordered black epaulets, five 76.2-mm AA guns, and 17 trucks with numbers of the [REDACTED] series left Frankfurt/Oder by rail. The direction of departure could not be determined. *

* 25X1A Comment. The AAA units loaded on 25 and 26 February 1951 were components of the unidentified AAA Div, possibly the 32nd. Compare with information by another source reporting on a unit of the same division which left Kuestrin by train for Jueterbog on 26 February 1951. [REDACTED] 25X1A
