[REDACTED] about 250 Soviet troops, including 11 officers, were stationed in Rerik (M 55/0 51) on 6 and 7 February 1951. The Soviet post commander in Rerik, a major, was seen riding in passenger car [REDACTED] on 6 February. The troops permanently stationed in the town were allegedly equipped with 20 trucks, including truck [REDACTED]. It was said that firing practice there would be resumed in March 1951. \*
