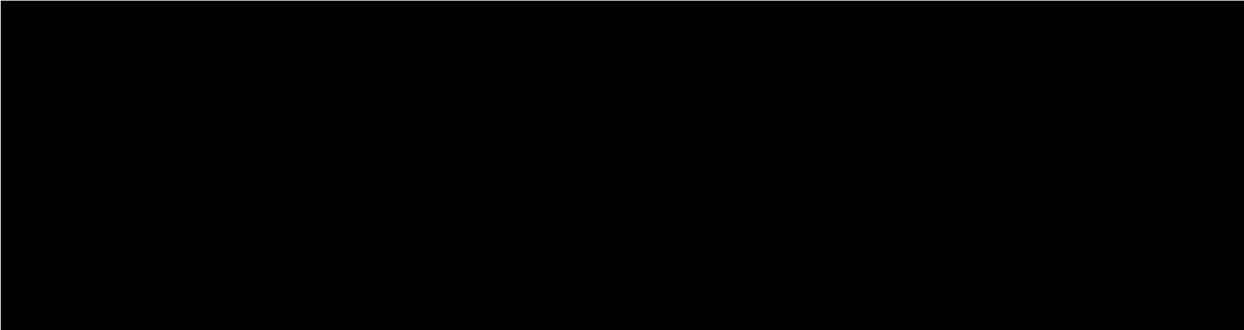

- 1. On 10 February 1950 the federation of Labor in Macao set up a Labor Traitors Purge Committee with the following members:*

- 2. The Seamen's Union in Macao was instructed by the Seamen's Federation in Canton to organize a Seamen's Anti-American Patriotic Reserve Corps, with KUO Ju* as its leader. Unemployed seamen will constitute the majority of the members, who will receive one month's training. Some are to be trained at the Marines' training center on Santsao Island.**
- 3. On 11 February 1951 the Chinese Communist Special Commissioner's Office in Macao was instructed to organize a Cultural workers' Corps, consisting of 30 members recruited from unemployed young men or students, the New Democracy Association and the Students' Association. Members of this unit were ultimately to serve in the Chinese Communist armed forces. In the same directive, the Special Commissioner's Office was told to keep a watch on transportation personnel who have received Communist training, including persons engaged in sea and land transport between Macao and mainland China. Such persons were not to be discharged from their position, nor were they to be allowed to resign without permission from the Communist organizations

from which they received their indoctrination.

4. On 14 February the Special Commissioner's Office received further instructions to keep a close watch on the activities of people who go from Macao to the mainland. They were also instructed to look out for forgery of exit and entry permits by Nationalist agents in Macao.
