Although the Hungarian government has claimed publicly that hundreds of families that had left Hungary in 1945 have returned in consequence of the amnesty decree, the actual figures are much smaller. In a period of nearly a month at the height of the campaign (20 July to 24 August 1950) a total of 99 persons returned, of whom 95 were of Hungarian nationality and 4 were ethnic Germans ("Volksdeutsche").
