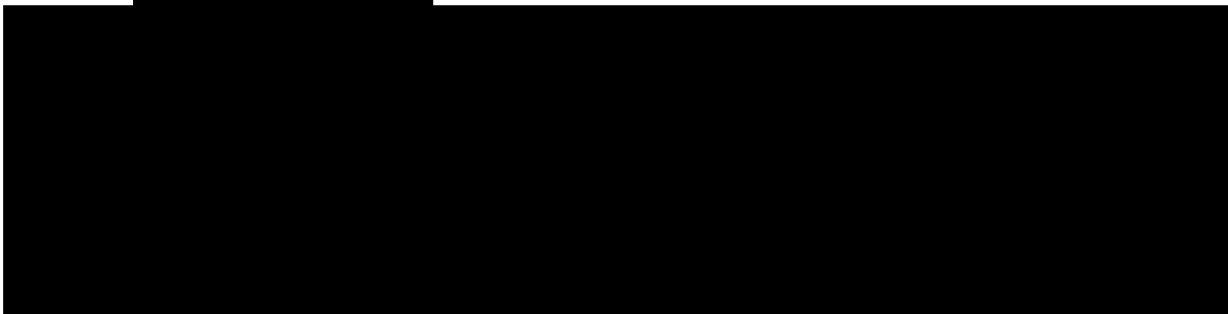

SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO.



1. On 21 March 300 drums of gasoline arrived at Nanning via the Hunan-Kwangsi Railroad. After an immediate inspection by two Communist army officers and a Soviet, the gasoline was taken to the airfield. The mark 100 was observed on each drum.*
2. Over 500,000 cattles of food are stored in two warehouses in Nanning. One is at Ch'ing Yun Chieh and is controlled by the Supply and Service Command of the Kwangsi Military District; the other is at 7 and 9 Tao Yuan Road and is controlled by the Supplies Control Department of the Nanning Military Control Commission.
3. Since mid-January between twenty and thirty trucks have been constantly transporting food from these warehouses, and between 1-20 February 180 truck-loads were taken away.**
