No indications of changes in the occupation of Parchim (M 54/T 74) airfield were observed up to 7 March 1951. Two biplanes, four single-engine, low-wing monoplanes and 20 MiG-15s were seen at the field on 28 February. The black numbers 01, 08, 09, 24, 26, and 28 were observed on six jet fighters. *

* Comment. The report confirms the belief that the occupation of Parchim airfield has not changed. One fighter regiment, equipped with MiG-15s jet fighters, is still believed to be stationed at the field. The black aircraft numbers are typical of this regiment. The numbers 01 and 08 are reported for the first time. As of 7 March, 13 different numbers have been identified on aircraft stationed in Parchim.
