1. The Flak Kaserne on Luëbschestrasse, Wismar (7 5h/T 49), was occupied by artillery and infantry units on 21 February 1951. Most of the soldiers observed wore red-bordered black epaulets, some of them with artillery insignia. Only a few soldiers wore black-bordered red epaulets. Motor [REDACTED] the last one being marked with a white triangle and occupied by a lieutenant colonel wearing red-bordered black epaulets. *

2. [REDACTED] were parked in front of the officers' billets opposite the Flak Kaserne. The former German Air Force hospital and the barracks installation on Parkstrasse housed Germans employed at the Wismar shipyard. **

* Comment. The information rather definitely indicates that the Flak Kaserne quarters the 288th Gds Mtz Rifle Regt and the 199th Gds Arty Regt, both of the 94th Gds Mtz Rifle Div. The location of component units of this division there is also confirmed by the motor vehicle numbers reported. See
