1. It was learned on 16 March 1951 that the units in Fuerstenwalde were scheduled to go to Lieberose during the period from 28 March to 14 April(1). General Gusov, (fnu), the commanding general of the division, left Fuerstenwalde for reassignment. The name of his successor has not been determined.(2)

2. Small tank units trained in Lieberose in mid-March. A unit from the Frankfurt/Oder military post was loaded at the Lieberose railroad station on 9

3. Lieutenant Colonel Pamin, (fnu), left Frankfurt/Oder for reassignment. He was succeeded by Lieutenant Colonel Platonov, (fnu). (4)

(1) In view of last year's information, it is probable that the troops will leave for the Lieberose troop training grounds to begin their summer training at the time specified in the present report. The only other report on this subject which has been received from the army area indicates that component units of the 25th Tank Div in Oranienburg would leave for Templin at the end of April 1951.
