Between 5 and 9 March 1951 source learned from a German laborer employed in the barracks installation in Kuestrin (O 53/V 66) that the approximately 1,800 men stationed there, 800 left for field training some time ago, allegedly going to Jueterbog (N 52/E 69). Some AAA units were observed on the highway between Frankfurt/Oder and Kuestrin during the period from 5 to 9 March. A total of 18 to 20 motor vehicles, including field kitchens and an ambulance, and 4 artillery pieces were observed with the units. The artillery pieces were on carriages with four wheels having pneumatic tires.

\* [Redacted] Comment. The statement that units of the unidentified AAA Div, possibly the 32nd, left Kuestrin for Jueterbog confirms previous information by other sources reporting that a train was dispatched to Jueterbog on 26 February 1951. Another source observed motor vehicles of the AAA Division in Jueterbog at the beginning of March 1951.
