3. The units located at Jueterbog-Neues Lager and the Damm airfield were alerted for a field exercise during the night of 7 February. Track-laying vehicles and trucks [Redacted] in the Fuchsberg Kaserne were subsequently seen leaving the post. [Redacted] this unit returned to the installation at 6:30 a.m. on 9 February. (3)

4. About 50 tank trucks and an undetermined number of other trucks loaded with gasoline drums were observed at the fuel depot in the former slaughterhouse within a three-hour period on 9 February 1951. [Redacted]

7. While the troops at the Damm airfield were alerted the morning of 8 February, no German worker was permitted to enter the billeting area. Tanks and motor vehicles were observed on all roads leading toward the Jueterbog railroad station from Dennowitz, the Damm airfield and Rohrbeck. All garages and barracks buildings at the Damm airfield were lighted the evening of 9 February. Ambulance [Redacted] and sedan [Redacted] left the Damm airfield barracks toward Jueterbog, while six trucks, [Redacted] occupied by soldiers with red-bordered black epaulets, were seen driving toward the airfield on 21 February.
