1. The Yugoslavs have recruited and organized into units 3,800 Albanians who are being given sabotage and espionage training. As soon as this training is completed, the men are smuggled into Albania.
2. Training centers are said to be located at Danilovgrad, Pristina and Primren. The senior commander of the group is a Yugoslav, Major Prodanovic, and the Albanian commander is Imini Thaci. The latter recruits the men, despatches them to Albania, and maintains contact with them.
