Chinese Communist military authorities established sixteen army depots along the Canton-Hankow Railroad and in south China coastal areas. The locations and heads of these depots are as follows:

1. Wuchang (114-17, 30-32)-Hankow depot -- in the railroad yards of the Wuchang East Railroad Station, headed by LIU Kuo-kuang (劉國光), brother of LIU Ch'uan-shu, head of the Hengyang Railway Bureau.
2. Changsha (112-59, 28-12) depot -- near the railroad hotel, Mao I Hsin (茅以新).
3. Hengyang depot -- headed by LIEN Feng-hsiang (連鳳翔), transportation adviser for the Hengyang Railroad.
4. Chuchiang (113-33, 24-50) depot -- in a foreign style house near Wopa (114-18, 24-41) railroad station, headed by CHANG Ying (張英).
5. Yingte (113-21, 24-12) depot -- in an old temple at the northeast end of the railroad station, headed by OU Chii (歐駒).
6. Canton depot -- in the wharf warehouse on the bank of the Huang Ho (黃河), headed by CH'U P'ei-chi (曲丕基).
7. Shihlung (113-51, 23-07) depot -- in an old-fashioned Chinese building, a former pawn shop, on the main street, headed by HO Lan-ch'ing (何蘭清).
8. Changmitou (114-06, 22-53) depot -- in a private house near the railroad station, headed by KAO Ou-yuan (高歐元).
9. Shenchuan (114-08, 22-32) depot -- in the East River Truck Transport Company building and a nearby private house, headed by CH'EN Han-kan (陳漢金).
10. Foshan (113-08, 23-02) depot -- in a private house near the railroad station,
