REMARKS

50X1-HUM

1. Between 16 and 25 February 1951, sedan [redacted] of Colonel Sasha Yelko, commanding officer of Tank [redacted], and sedan [redacted] of Lieutenant Colonel Trobinov (fnu) were identified among the Soviet vehicles sheltered in the large underground garage on Laisenhof in Dresden (N 52/F 29). (1) 50X1

2. Motor vehicles observed in the SS Kaserne "Wilder Mann" on 27 February [redacted]

3. The buildings in the northeastern section of the Adolf Hitler Kaserne were separated from the rest of the billeting area by a board fence. [redacted] they were used for storage purposes. Motor vehicles seen there included passenger car [redacted] driven by a soldier with red-bordered black epaulets; truck [redacted] driven by a soldier with red-bordered green epaulets; and trucks [redacted] the drivers of which wore red-bordered black epaulets. Only a few soldiers wearing red-bordered black epaulets without branch-of-service insignia were seen in the billeting area proper. Sedan [redacted] was parked there, together with five other sedans. 4. Gate guards in front of the Maschinengewehr Kaserne and a few soldiers seen in the billeting area wore red-bordered black epaulets. No training activity or vehicular traffic was noticed. Four trucks and two passenger cars were parked in the barracks yard. [redacted] 50X1-HUM

5. Motor vehicles observed in the Grenadier Kaserne on Kurt Fischer Allee included sedan [redacted] driven by a soldier with red-bordered black epaulets; sedan [redacted] occupied by three officers wearing tank insignia; sedan [redacted] driven by a soldier with red-bordered black epaulets; sedans [redacted] the drivers of which wore red-bordered green epaulets; sedan [redacted] driven by a soldier with black-bordered green epaulets; and trucks [redacted] the drivers of which wore red-bordered black epaulets. 6. According to the lights in the SS Kaserne "Wilder Mann", on the evening of 2 March, the number of troops quartered there was estimated at 800. Motor vehicles [redacted] were seen in barracks traffic. (2) 50X1-HUM

Comments.

(1) The large garage at Luisenhof is reported for the first time. Like other civilian installations at Luisenhof, Dresden-Weisser Hirsch, the garage is probably constructed into the steep slope of the Elbe River bank. It is not a bomb-proof installation. 50X1-HUM

[redacted] Since the two sedans probably belonged to an SCC office in Dresden, and since such agencies are believed to be located at Weisser Hirsch, there is some reason to conclude that the two field-grade officers belonged to the SCC. 50X1-HUM

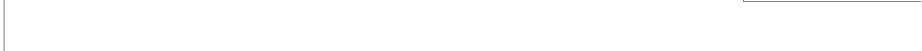
(2) The strength estimate of the troops in the SS Kaserne "Wilder Mann", agrees with reports by other sources. 50X1-HUM
The installation probably quarters the unidentified Iiv Tank SP Regt of the First Gds Mecz Army. 50X1-HUM

Since the motor vehicles observed at the installation belonged to the three divisions and the headquarters AT artillery of the First Gds Mecz Army, it is believed that an army repair shop or service station is also located there.

(3) The present and previous reports [redacted] did not allow any conclusions as to the identity of the units in the Adolf Hitler Kaserne. A signal or artillery unit, an equipment depot and a motor vehicle repair shop may be located there. 50X1-HUM

(4) The information does not indicate any change regarding the occupation of the Maschinengewehr Kaserne. 50X1-HUM

(5) No information is available on the occupation of the partially destroyed Grenadier Kaserne on the south side of Kurt Fischer Allee. 50X1-HUM
