1. On 25 February 57 drums of gasoline, 20 drums of Diesel oil, and 23 drums of lubricating oil were transported in five trucks from Macao to Shihchi'i (113-22, 22-30).
2. On 9 March 3 jeeps, 66 drums of gasoline, and 40 drums of tar were transported on the LUNG MAN (龍門) from Macao to Canton.
3. On 12 March about 1,500 gunny bags and 32 drums of gasoline were transported in three trucks from Macao to Shihchi'i.
