1. On 2 April 1951, the Reichsbahn General Directorate was ordered by the Russian authorities to study
  - a. the feasibility of running trains from East to West on both lines of double track railway lines in the Soviet Zone,
  - b. the feasibility of running 60 trains within a period of six hours from East to West on both lines.
2. The Reichsbahn has replied that the above propositions are feasible.
