- On 30 March 1951, the Luftnachrichten Kaserne, Bernau (N 53/2 96), seemed to be occupied to capacity. Sixteen medium AT guns, three artillery pieces of undetermined type, and a T-34 tank chassis were seen in the billeting area. [redacted]

Trucks [redacted] and two tank cars [redacted] were seen at the fuel dump. Truck [redacted] driven by a soldier with red-bordered black epaulets from the barracks installation, was identified at a point north-northwest of the installation. [redacted]

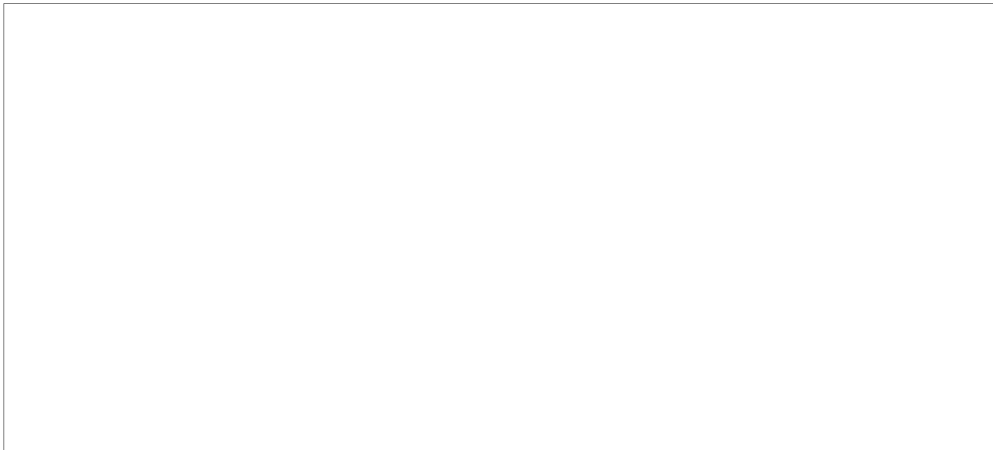





2. On 30 March the pigeon station was guarded by sentries with black-bordered red epaulets. Only a few soldiers were seen between the wooden barracks buildings. About 60 soldiers wearing black-bordered red epaulets were receiving instruction in groups in the area east of the road to Ruednitz. No training activity was observed in the pigeon station from 5:30 to 5:45 p.m. on 3 April. Forty trucks  were seen in the truck shed. The four AA  gun emplacements contained one canvas-covered gun each.

3. No training activity was observed at the Luftnachrichten Kaserne between 6:15  and 6:35 p.m. on 4 April. Fourteen artillery pieces and five ammunition carriers were parked near Schoenower Chaussee.
