1. In early March 1951, PT boats were being built in the Klaus Engelbrecht Yard in Berlin-Oberschoeneweide, also known as Jachtwerft Berlin, for the Soviet Navy. The boats were completely fitted at the yard.
2. The PT boats were 20 meters long and were fitted with two IC-engines of 1,200 HP each.
3. The wooden keels for the boats were cut at the Adlershof Sawmill. The engines were supplied by R. Wolf in Lagdeburg-Buckau.
