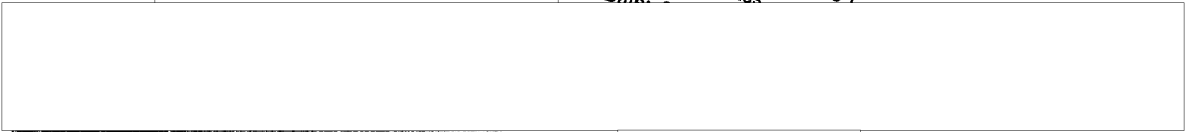

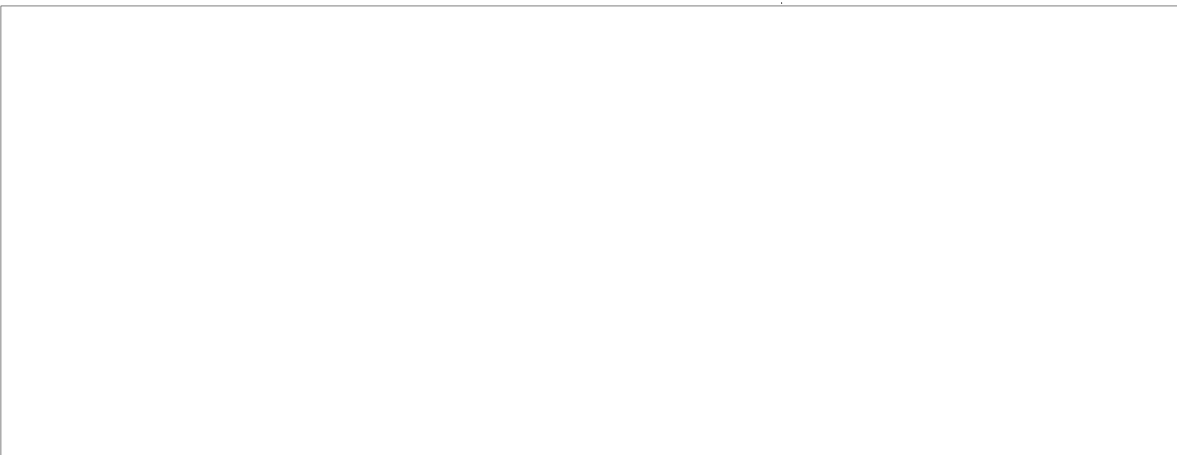

Chinese Communist Order of Battle, Korea

1. As of 29 April approximately 220, 00 crack combat troops of the 4 Field Army had been killed or wounded in Korea, and LIN Piao was still recuperating from wounds received in February at Sinuiju.

2. Of approximately 300,000 men of the 5 Field Army, approximately 120,000 have been killed or wounded. These were replaced by an equal number of troops from the 19 Army Group.

3. [REDACTED] the Chinese Communists [REDACTED] sent 701,200 combat troops into Korea, exclusive of an undetermined number of support troops. Total Chinese Communist casualties in Korea have been 420,178, including 238,535 killed in action or dead from wounds received in action, 67,212 wounded and 114,431 (sic) captured or missing in action [REDACTED]

4. During April the 49 and 50 Divisions of the Chinese Communist 17 Army and the 52 Division of the 18 Army were at Ichon (126-53, 38-30).

5. [redacted] the 89 and 90 Divisions of the Chinese Communist 30 Army were in Korea. The 88 Division was recently reorganized into a marine division. CHOU Han-chung (周漢中), commander of the 30 Army, was recently transferred to Naval General Headquarters to become its chief of staff.³

Soviet Forces, Manchuria

6. Soviet infantry troops transferred to P'ingtingpao (平頂堡) from Dairon [redacted] wore a CPA breastplate in addition to the regular Chinese Communist uniform. On the reverse side of the breastplate was a code number identifying the specific Soviet unit.

8. [redacted] there were 20, 00 Japanese prisoners of war in the Harbin area; most were artillery troops. [redacted] these were being sent in groups to Korea for duty with the Chinese Communist troops.

9. [redacted] the hospital of the Chinese Communist 201 Unit (sic) was at Dairon.
10. [redacted] the 7 Company of the 2 Battalion of the Chinese Communist 902 Unit (sic) was at Changchun.
11. [redacted] elements of the Chinese Communist 48 Army were at Ch'ongte (117-52, 40-59).⁶
12. [redacted] elements of the Chinese Communist 37 Unit (sic) were at Szutaokou (四道溝), in the Antung area.

13. Of approximately 100,000 transportation personnel conscripted in the Northeast, approximately 37,000 have been lost. Of approximately 22,000 members of a railway repair unit which was divided into 22 groups to maintain the North Korean railways, approximately 3,900 have been lost. It is very difficult to find replacements for these railway workers.

14. [redacted] 5,000 horses were shipped to the Sino-Korean border area to replace horses being used by the Chinese Communist cavalry. Part of the horses were from a forced purchase of 3,000 horses in Tsinghai during the winter of 1950 by the Northwest Skin and Fur Company. Most of the horses were turned over to 4 Field Army authorities.

15. [redacted] the Chinese Communist first rear hospital was at Sian.

1. [redacted] Comment. [redacted] the Chinese language newspaper Kung Shang Jih Pao published in Hong Kong gave 311,789 Chinese Communist combat troops and 49,814 non-combat personnel as killed in action and 3,487 as captured in Korea.

3. [redacted] Comment. [redacted] one division of the 30 Army was on the Sino-Korean border and two divisions were in Korea.
