           the North Korean Labor Party Central Executive Committee met to discuss the problem of the inefficiency of Party workers during the war. The committee agreed that the following errors were made:

50X1-HUM

- a. Party workers in the army could not thoroughly indoctrinate new troops with Communism and could not effectively mobilize civilian leaders of potential guerrilla groups to fight for the North Koreans in the Republic of Korea.
- b. Party members in government agencies failed to mobilize raw materials and supplies needed by front line troops.
- c. Party members at headquarters failed to give flexible orders to Party workers in external organizations and failed to coordinate Party members at home.
