1. The Nan Kuang Company made the following shipments by water from Macao to Kongmoon:
 - a. 21 May: 30 drums of gasoline, 2* tons of crude rubber, and 8 trucks.
 - b. 22 May: 14* tons of iron sheets, 3 boxes of medicines, and 9 trucks.
 - c. 23 May: 20 drums of gasoline and 2* tons of crude rubber.
 - d. 24 May: 11 tons of iron sheets, 3 boxes of medicines, 30 drums of gasoline and 5 trucks.
 - e. 25 May: 10 drums of coal tar, 11 tons of crude rubber, and 2 boxes of medicine.
 - f. 26 May: 10 drums of gasoline, 11 tons of iron, 16* tons of crude rubber, and 5 trucks.
 - g. 27 May: 20 drums of gasoline, 10 drums of coal tar, 2 boxes of medicine, 1 1/2 tons of crude rubber, and 15* tons of iron.
2. The Nan Kuang Company made the following shipments by water from Macao to Canton:
 - a. 22 May: 10 drums of gasoline, 50 tires, and 2 trucks.
 - b. 23 May: 10 drums of gasoline, 4 boxes of automobile spare parts, and 2 boxes of photographic supplies.
 - c. 24 May: 5 drums of coal tar, 500 tires, and 14* tons of crude rubber.
 - d. 25 May: 15 drums of gasoline, 10 drums of coal tar, and 3 boxes of medicine.

 - f. 27 May: 20 drums of gasoline, and 1 box of photographic supplies.
3. The Nan Kuang Company made the following shipments by water from Macao to Shihch'i:
- a. 22 May: 700 drums of petroleum, 20 drums of residue fats, 11 tons of iron sheets, and 15* tons of crude rubber.
 - b. 24 May: 1,000 drums of petroleum, 15 drums of coal tar, and 16* tons of iron sheets.
 - c. 26 May: 800 drums of petroleum and 30 drums of gasoline.
