1. On the evening of 10 May 1951 the Ministers of Internal Affairs of all six Yugoslav republics met in Belgrade. Aleksandar Rankovic, Minister of Internal Affairs for Yugoslavia, presided at the conference. Although nothing is known of the proceedings, the meeting had to do with the seriousness of the current political situation.
2. The six ministers returned to their respective republics that same evening.
