To the west of Koin Railread Station (126-23, 40-30), there is an airfield used by MIG jet planes. The field is 150 meters (approximately 164 yards)\*\* wide and has a runway 1500 meters (approximately 1640 yards ) long. It is designed to handle approximately 50 MIG jet planes.

- 2. Planes which land at this field are immediately camouflaged with large paper covers, which concest a plane completely and are painted to look like thatched roofs of barns or farmhouses. They are approximately 10 meters (40 yards) in extent. The airfield is camouflaged as a rice paddy.
- The field was constructed between 9 and 13 December 1950.\*\*\*\* Approximately 30,000 workers were mobilized daily for the purpose.
- In early April 1951, there were no local reports as to whether the field had been bombed. It was considered a potential source of important resistance to UN air activities.

Comment. The position and layout of the field are shown in Attach-25X1A ment A. From the description and diagram, this appears to be a landing strip rather than an airfield.

25X1Ā<sup>\*</sup> Comment. This seems very narrow. The site is apparently restricted by the closemess of mountains and river on one side and railroad on the other.
