1. Underground hangars are being constructed at Kangdong (126-05, 39-09), Songch'on (126-13, 39-15), and Taedong-ni (? 126-15, 39-16). The technical advisers for this work [redacted] were brought into Korea by the Chinese Communists. 50X1-HUM
2. Headquarters of the North Korean II Corps is at P'yongsan (126-26, 38-16).
3. The North Korean 5 and 6 Divisions are at Kanpo (? Kangp'o-dong, 126-03, 38-41).
4. Headquarters of the North Korean I Corps is at Changdan (126-45, 37-56).
5. The North Korean 2 and 4 Divisions are deployed at the Imjin River defense line.
6. Headquarters of the Chinese Communist 41 Division (sic),¹ 4 Field Army is at Sirmak (126-14, 38-25).
7. There is a North Korean field hospital in the official quarters of a cement factory south of Sariwon.
8. [redacted] there were no Communist troops in Sariwon or Hwangju (125-47, 38-40). 50X1-HUM

1. Comment. [redacted] the 41 Division, which is subordinate to the 2 Field Army, was in Yunnan 50X1-HUM
