1. In early May 1951 the Chinese Communists ordered all Communist purchasing agents in Hong Kong and Macao to return to Canton to discuss in an emergency meeting measures to be taken against the Anglo-American embargo on exports of strategic materials to China. The atmosphere of the meeting was extremely tense. The possible embargo of food exports to China was discussed.
2. During the meeting a report was received saying that on 12 May the SS HSIN SHENG LI¹ arrived at Macao with a cargo including 1,000 rubber tires, more than 100 cases of automobile parts, more than 100 cases of TNT, and 20 automobile engines. The explosives were stored in the Hsin Chung Hang, and the rest of the cargo was kept by [] in the Nao Auang Hang.
