1. On 9 May 1951, the Flak Kaserne in Brandenburg (W 53/Z 23) was occupied by only a guard detail. Gate guards wore red-bordered black epaulets. [REDACTED] toward Altengrabow or returning from that direction.

2. On 9 May, the Generalfeldzeugmeister Kaserne quartered about 2,000 troops. Sentries at the gates were antitankmen. [REDACTED]

3. Tank troops were no longer seen in the Pionier Kaserne on Einstein Strasse on 9 May. [REDACTED] impression that the whole tank unit from the installation had departed without leaving a housekeeping detail behind. About two-thirds of the billeting space was vacant, and the remainder of the billets quartered air force personnel. \*
