On 5 May 1951, the Marstall Kaserne in Ludwigslust (M 54/T 53) was occupied by only a rear detail of soldiers who wore red-bordered black epaulets with artillery insignia. A barracks employee stated that the troops from the installation had moved to the Schweinrich training area between 19 and 21 April. He added that Techentin airfield was also occupied by only rear units with a strength of one tank company and one battery. The troops from the airfield had also moved to Schweinrich. Only a few soldiers, who wore red-bordered black epaulets with artillery and tank insignia, a wrecker [REDACTED] were observed at the airfield on 5 May. The southern entrance at the airfield installations was blocked by a tree which two soldiers under the supervision of a major who wore tank insignia had cut down. \*
