The present report confirms that the units of the 11th 3ds Tank Div, including the 10th 3ds Tank logt from the Hermann Goering Kaserne and the Napola, departed for the troop training grounds.

Machine gun companies have never before been observed in the Loviet Lone of Germany and can belong only to an infentry unit. They may be components of the 27th Gds Ltz Rifle Regt of the 11th Gds Tank Div which is believed to be stationed somewhere in Dresden, but it is doubted that there should have been as many as seven machine gun companies. It is also possible that the companies were components of the motorcycle battalion of the First Gds Lecz Army or the 11th Gds Tank Div. The filling station and the warehouse for
