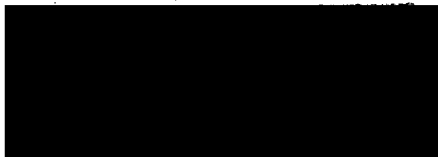

1. In early June the CHUNGKING left for Dairen for painting and mechanical inspection.
2. The CH'ANGCHIH (長治) left Tsingtao on 1 June for Shanghai and departed from Shanghai later in the month. The former captain, SHEN T'ing-chu (沈廷柱), was sent to a naval hospital with tuberculosis and was replaced by TAI Ping-fan (戴秉範), chief of the Second Section, Naval Operations Bureau, Chinese Communist Naval Headquarters.
