

- In late June 1951 the midland Company of Hong Kong ordered the following supplies to be sent by air as soon as possible from hamburg, Germany: three sets of X-ray equipment with accessories, and a large number of dynamometers and instruments for operations on the eye. The combined value of the items was HK #164,800*. Letter of credit facilities had been arranged through the Lercantile Bank of India, Limited.
- 2. The Man Kuang Company made the following shipments by water from Macao to Kongmoon:
 - 40 drums of gasoline, 600 drums of kerosene, 10 drums of residue 21 June: fats, and 80 sets of truck tires.
 - 22 June: 40 drums of gasoline, 20 drums of residue fate, 80 sets of truck tires, and 5 boxes of truck parts.
 - 23 June: 50 drums of gasoline, 600 drums of kerosene, 10 drums of coal tar, and ll* tons of crude rubber.
 - 24 June: 40 drums of gasoline, 700 drums of kerosene, 30 drums of residue fats, 13* tons of crude rubber, and 3 boxes of drugs.
 - 25 June: 60 drums of gasoline, 600 drums of kerosene, 10 drums of residue fats, and 13* tons of crude rubber.
- The Nan Kuang Company made the following shipments by water from Macao to Canton:

18 June: 80 drums of gasoline, 60 drums of resi crude rubber, and b boxes of drugs. - b. 21 June: 160 drums of gasoline, 60 drums of residue fats, 120 sets of truck tires, 22* tons of iron plates, and 8 boxes of truck parts.
- c. 22 June: 30 drums of gasoline, 10 drums of goal tar, 80 sets of truck tires, 9* tons of grude rubber, and 4 boxes of drugs.
- d. 23 June: 80 drums of gasoline and 13* tons of crude rubber.
- e. 24 June: 40 drums of gasoline, 13* tons of orude rubber, 13* tons of scrap iron, and 13* tons of iron wire.
- f. 25 June: 120 drums of gasoline, 50 drums of coal tar, 18* tons of iron wire, and 4 boxes of truck parts.
- 4. The Nan Kuang Company made the following shipments by water from Macas to Stihch'i:
 - a. 18 June: 920 drums of gasoline, 60 drums of residue fats, and 120 sets of truck tires.
 - b. 21 Juns: 70 drums of gasoline and 60 drums of residue fats.
 - c. 23 June: 70 drums of gasoline, 600 drums of kerosene, 15 drums of coal tar, 30 drums of residue fats, and 80 sets of truck tires.
 - d. 24 June: 60 drums of gasoline. 700 drums of kerosene, and 5 boxes of truck parts.
