In 1950 Labor Schools (Rabotnicheski Fakultet) began operating in Sofia and Plovdiv. The schools were established for Communist Party members who have had to stop their education. There is no charge for tuition, and the students also receive money. Those who have completed their pre-gymnasium schooling may enter the Labor School after attending a Party course for two years. Those who have completed the fifth grade of the gymnasium may enter the Labor School after 12 to 14 months in a Party school. Those who have completed the gymnasium may enter after three to six months in a Party school.
