SUBJECT Chinese Communist Air Force Activities

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The following are activities of the Chinese Communist Air Force (CCAF) for the period 13 to 19 May 1951:\*

- a. On 13 May the CCAF made 33 sorties. The Antung field was closed at 0545, the Tsinan field at 0600 and 1140, the Ch'engtu field at 1600, the Chungking field at 0600 and 1600, and the Hankow field at 0600. The Yangts'un field was opened at 1623. From 1700 to 1900 two type-45 planes flew over Antung. At 0700 14 YAK-11 planes left Mukden under the command of LIN Hu (林虎) and returned to Mukden by way of Hsinmin (122-43, 41-59). Two WTB-2 senior trainers were dispatched from Mukden to reconnoiter a fire at Kuo K'uei Shan (居角金山) and San Tuo Ho Tzu (三道河子) in Northern Chahar.
- b. On 14 May the CCAF made 136 sorties. The Hankow field was closed at 0600 and opened at 1205, the Nanking field closed at 0700, and the Ch'engtu field closed at 0710 and opened at 0755. At 0600 ten MIG-15's, 1 YAK-11, and 14 YAK-17's took off from Anshan under the command of HAO-lao-tao-fu (郝老桃夫) (? Khalatov). At 0600 one YAK-12 left Mukden flown by Tu-wei-chin-k'o (董维金考) (? Davezhinko). At 0800 LIN Hu led 64 unidentified planes in a flight from Mukden. At 0530 hours 28 TU-2 planes took off from K'aiyuan.
- c. On 15 May the CCAF made 66 sorties. At 0900 one YAK-11 and 19 MIG-15 planes took off from Anshan under the command of LI K'e-ying (李克英). Flew over Hsinmin, and returned to Anshan at 1400 hours. KAO Lien-chin (高连金) led 12 MIG-15 planes in practice flights over Mukden between 1100 and 1400. One MIG-15 practiced flying over Antung between 0728 and 0858. Four IL-12 planes, numbered 23, 32, 38, and 39, and one transport, number 3006, took off and landed 17 times between 0812 and 1455 in the Hankow area.

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1. On 16 May the CCAF made 14 sorties. The Peiping south field was closed at 0950 and opened at 1500, the Ch'engtu field opened at 0740, and the Tungfeng field closed at 0550 because of rain. The Chungking airfield closed at 0730 and the Tsingtao field closed at 0930 and opened at 1140.
- e. On 17 May the CCAF made 20 sorties. The Ch'engtu airfield was closed at 0700 and 1500. The south field at Peiping was opened at 0500, and the Chungking field at 0940. Four MIG-15 planes practiced flying over Antung at 1700. One MIG-15 flew over Yangts'un at 0856. From 0831 to 1146 three IL-12's and one transport made 12 take-offs and landings in the course of training paratroopers.
- f. On 18 May the CCAF made 17 sorties. The Ch'engtu field was closed at 0700. At 1100 twelve MIG-15 planes commanded by KAO Lien-chin took off from Anshan, flew over Hsairmin, and returned to Anshan at 1400.
- g. On 19 May the CCAF made 28 sorties. The Ch'engtu field was opened at 0700 and the Hankow field closed at 0600. At 0600 eight MIG-9 planes practiced flying over Anshan, led by Hsao-lao-tao-fu. At 0815 eight MIG-15 planes made experimental flights over Antung. At 0605 and 0645 one MIG-15 flew over Antung.
