- 1. On 29 April four non-Oriental Soviets in blue business suits were seen in a sedan at Sukch on (125-37, 39-24).
- In early May one non-Oriental Soviet in uniform and three in civilian clothes were driving in a sedan toward downtown Payongyang from the west side of town.
- 3. In early May it was rumored in Yongyu (125-36, 39-18) and P'yongyang that more than 100 non-Oriental Soviet troops were in the Anju (125-40, 39-37) -Sinanju (125-36, 39-36) area, and an undetermined number were in Hamhung (127-32, 39-54).
- 4. A traveler to Anju in early May saw four trucks, each carrying about 25 non-Oriental troops, arrive at Anju. Residents of the towns the traveler passed through said that the trucks reached Anju via Unsan (125-48, 39-58), Pukenin (125-45, 40-12) and hanp of in (126-17, 41-09).
