- In late June there were approximately 250 planes in the East China Military Area including 70 transports, 50 jet fighters, 100 fighter-bombers, and 30 TU-2 bombers. The Chinese Communist authorities were planning to increase the number of planes in that area to 300, with approximately 50 additional planes of Soviet manufacture.
- In late June specially selected troops of the 3 Field Army, were receiving paratroop training at Manking, Shanghai, and Haichou (sio), with special emphasis on demolition techniques.
- On 4 July Chinese Communist Air Force activities included the following: a number of YAK-17's flew training missions from T'angshan (118-11, 39-38) and 10 LHG-15's were scheduled to leave Yangts'un for Liut'ing Airfield.
- On 4 July Ts'angk'ou Airfield, Tsingtao, closed at 6 a.m., opened at 1 p.m., closed at 2:15 p.m., opened at 4:50 p.m., closed at 6:12 p.m., and opened at 7:40 p.m. All airfields in the Lukden area opened at 8:25 a.m. Lanchow Airfield closed at 6 a.m. because of rain and a sand storm and opened at 8 a.m. Chani (103-48, 25-38) Airfield closed at 8 a.m.
- 5. On 4 July training missions from Anshan were as follows:
  - In the morning, 8 MIG-15's, 6 YAK-17's, and 2 YAK-11's with CH'IU K'o-ying as flight leader to Hsimmin (122-48, 41-59), Fushum (123-54, 41-53), and back to Anshan,
  - b. In the afternoon, 15 MIG-15's, 2 YAK-11's, and 4 YAK-17's with KAO Lien-chin as flight leader to Heinmin, Fushum, and back to Anshan at altitudes of 1,600-32,000 feet.
- On 4 June the following Chinese Communist air activities took place:
  - At 6 a.m. one YAK-12 piloted by Pa-li-shao-fu (巴里少夫 )(? Barisov) left Antung for Lukden via Anshan.

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- b. At 10:30 a.m. IL-12's Numbers 17, 25, and 29 left Peiping for Hankow, where they arrived at 2:15 p.m. All were scheduled to fly to Ch<sup>3</sup> angtu on 5 July.
- c. At 3:30 p.m. civil transport Number 04 arrived at Chita from Peiping.
- d. At 4:04 p.m. one YAK-type plane arrived at Anshan.
- At 4:53 p.m. transport Number 8001 left Ch'engtu for Chungking, where it arrived at 5:55 p.m.
- f. Plane Number 121 left Hankow for Peiping.
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
