1. The Kwangtung Government has ordered all skilled laborers and technicians of the underground arms and ammunition manufacturing shops in Kwangtung to register themselves and to surrender their machinery and equipment. About 2,000 have registered and have been given jobs by the Communist authorities.
2. About 600 of these men have been given jobs in various arms repair shops and arsenals in Canton. About 1,000 have been assigned to work in local ordnance factories and repair shops on the Kwangsi-Vietnam border.
